Freshman finished 37-6 ... won 96-pound Class A title ... placed first at State Qualifiers ... competed at New York state meet for first time ... two-year varsity wrestler ... carries a B average in classroom ... Parents are Bob and Lori Dierna ... plans to attend college after 2011 graduation.

Parents are Steve and Cindy Walton ... will attend University at Buffalo.

**Chris Marvin, Wayne**

Senior finished 40-4 this season ... two-time sectional champ won the 160-pound Class A title this winter ... four-year starter competed in the NY state championship tourney ... plans to join the Marines ... Parents are Kim and Richard Marvin ... also plays football.
