Penfield wins wrestling tournament

It was a big day for Penfield in the Genesee Valley Wrestling tournament at Geneseo High School.

The Patriots placed first in the 29-team tournament, earning their first major title in school history.

Ryan Nicoletta of Penfield pinned five different opponents and earned the aggregate pin award for the most pins in the least amount of time. C.J. Fogle earned Most Valuable Player of the meet for the Patriots.

"It was an outstanding performance for a group of kids in their first major team tournament this season," Penfield coach John Leone said. "In the semifinals we went 7-for-7 which is pretty rare."

Nicoletta pinned Matt Hasbrouck of Marion in 39 seconds in the final at 112 pounds.

Fogle decisioned Steve McNally of Byron-Bergen 5-2 in the title match at 125 pounds.
